**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

- 1. Where & when is registration for the first day of camp?**
  - Registration is on Monday (first day of camp) between 8-9 am in the Crisler Center lobby.
- 2. What is the point of registration if I already paid / signed up online?**
  - To get checked-in, verify camp bank amount and to receive your camp t-shirt.
- 3. What time will camp begin each day?**
  - Camp will begin at 9:00 am each day inside the Crisler Center. We will allow campers to be dropped off as early as 8:00 am each day for those parents who have to go to work.
- 4. What time can I pick my camper up?**
  - You can pick up your camper at 4:00 pm each day inside the Crisler Center.
- 5. Can my camper stay later than 4:00 pm?**
  - No. Unfortunately we are not guaranteed the gym after 4:00 pm so we ask that all campers be picked up by 4:00 pm ET sharp! Thank you for your understanding.
- 6. Can someone other than me pick up my camper?**
  - Yes, carpooling is not only allowed but encouraged. Each camper will simply need to identify the person picking them up and let their camp coach know before being dismissed.
- 7. How does the camp bank work?**
  - The camp bank is like a debit account. At the beginning of camp, you can deposit any amount of money into your campers account. Your camper can use the account throughout the week to purchase snacks and drinks from the camp store. When your camper makes a purchase, the amount will be deducted from the total available.
- 8. What do I need to do about medications for my camper?**
  - We will have a certified trainer on site at all times. Our trainer will collect all medications as well as monitor food allergies that any camper may have.
- 9. Will Michigan players and coaches be at camp?**
  - Yes! Both Michigan players and coaches will be at camp.
- 10. Will campers be split up by ages / grade?**
  - Yes. We will split our camp into multiple leagues based on campers' age / grade.
- 11. Will lunch be provided?**
  - Yes. Lunch will be provided each day. We recommend all campers eat breakfast before camp.
- 12. Can parents / guardians watch throughout the day?**
  - Yes. There is plenty of room for parents / guardians to watch throughout the day.
